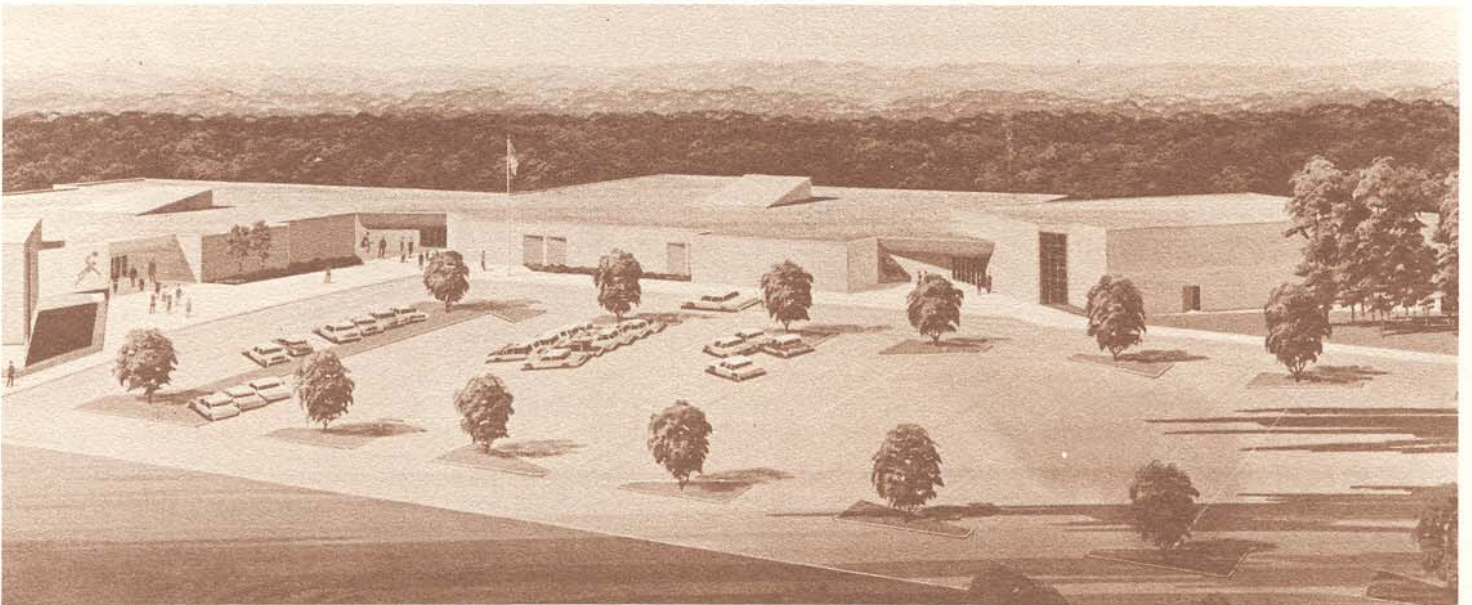

WILLIAM HENRY SHAW HIGH SCHOOL

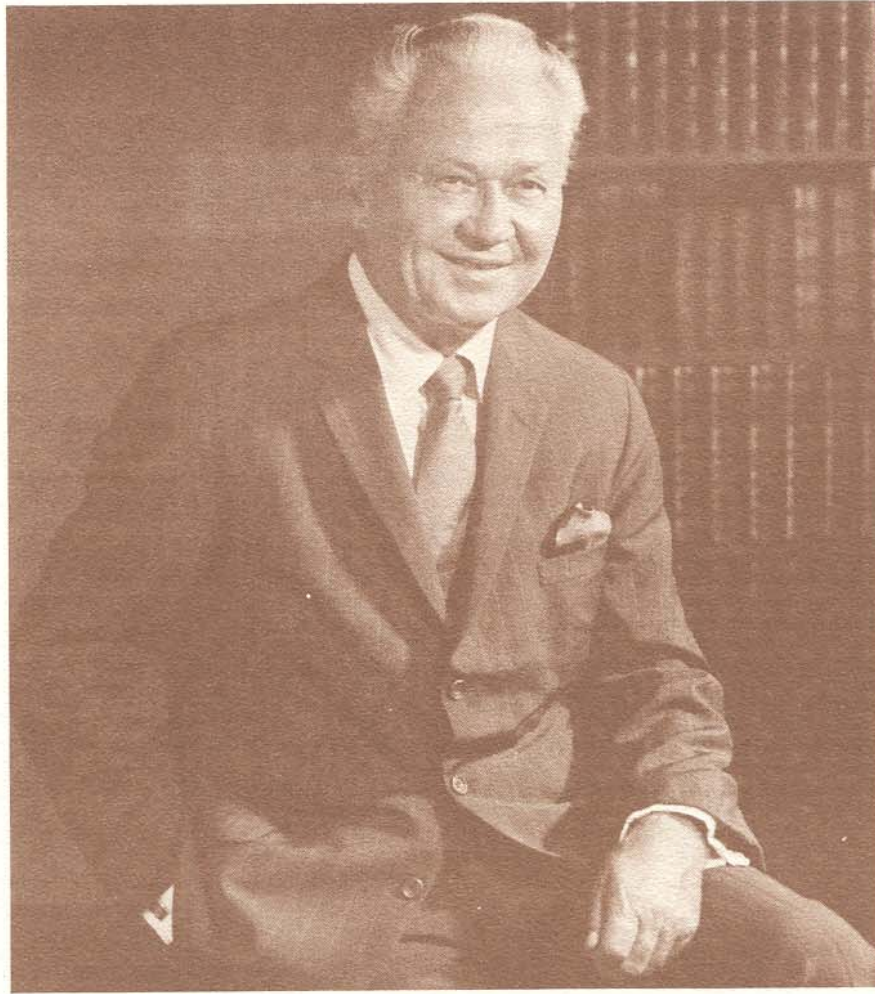

DR. WILLIAM HENRY SHAW

Dr. William Henry Shaw, a native of Durham, North Carolina, holds the B.A. and M.Ed. degrees from Duke University and the Doctorate in Education (Ed.D.) from Auburn University. Additional academic pursuits include one year of graduate work in School Administration at Teachers College of Columbia University.

Prior to his illustrious career as the near incomparable Educator of Columbus, Georgia, Dr. Shaw served as Principal of school systems in Durham County and Raleigh, North Carolina; and as Superintendent of the City Systems in Sumter, South Carolina. In September 1945, he accepted the Superintendency of the Columbus Public Schools; and, when on January 1, 1950, the City and County Systems merged, he became Superintendent of Education for the Muscogee County School District and remained in that position until his retirement in 1973.

Dr. Shaw has served as an instructor in Educational Administration at Duke University, University of South Carolina, Florida State University, and as administrative assistant at Teachers College, Columbia University, New York. He is presently on the staff at Columbus College. He is a member of Phi Beta Kappa, Phi Delta Kappa and Delta Kappa Pi. He served as President of the Georgia Education Association in 1955-56 and was District Governor (South Carolina) of Rotary International, 1944-45. Dr. Shaw is a past member of the Executive Committee of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, and is a member of the American Association of Colleges and Schools, and served on the Advisory Committee in the past years. He is a Life Member of the Georgia Education Association, the National Education Association, and the Georgia Congress of Parents and Teachers.

During the celebration of the one hundredth anniversary of the schools in Columbus and Muscogee County, the citizens of Muscogee County declared May 3, 1968, as "William Henry Shaw Day". On June 21, 1970, a fountain at 1200 Bradley Drive was dedicated in his honor. On January 16, 1978, the Board of Education voted to name the Schomburg-North High School the William Henry Shaw High School in his honor.

The Columbus Public Schools were established by an act of the General Assembly of Georgia on December 28, 1866, based upon a resolution which was introduced by Alderman John McIlhenny, providing for a public school system, and adopted by the City Council of Columbus on November 19, 1866.

The Muscogee County School System was organized on September 12, 1872, following action by the General Assembly of Georgia providing for public schools in the several counties of the state.

By Constitutional Amendment in 1948 and by Act of the Legislature in 1949 and vote of the people of Columbus and Muscogee County, the Columbus Public Schools merged on January 1, 1950, with the Muscogee County Schools, known thereafter as the Muscogee County Board of Education of the Muscogee County School District.
